Key Topics to be covered

LATEX:

Text formatting, page layout, listing of items, table preparation, figure insertion, equation writing, bibliography preparation (including the use of Mendeley and JabRef reference managers), article and thesis writing, slide preparation, poster preparation, user-defined macros etc.

RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION ETHICS:

Research misconduct (fabrication, falsification, plagiarism), authorship ethics, plagiarism prevention, peer review integrity, data management, ethical guidelines for human/non-human studies, intellectual property rights, and addressing conflicts of interest.
