Guidelines for Ph.D. Entrance Test MO -2026

Candidates should read the Guidelines carefully.

Date, Time and Venue of the Ph.D. Entrance Test:

The General Aptitude Test and Subject Specific Test will be held on **23rd May 2026, 10:00 am to 12:00 pm.**

Note: Download your admit card/hall ticket from ERP Login. ([ERP Link](#)) (to be available by 1:00 PM 20th May 2026)

Venue: BIT Mesra and Off Campuses at Patna, Noida & Jaipur(as displayed in the shortlisted list)

Details of the Written Test:

- The test will be conducted in physical mode.
- There shall be two sections:
 - I.) Common Aptitude Section - 45 minutes, 50 MCQ (2 marks each), Total: 100 marks
 - II.) Subjects Specific Section - 75 minutes, 40 MCQ (2 marks each) + 4 Subjective (5 marks each), Total:100 marks
- There will NOT be any negative marking.
- Syllabus as per UGC-NET / GATE / CSIR-NET (as applicable).

Instruction For Candidates

1. Candidates must report to the examination centre at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
2. Bring a valid photo ID (Aadhaar Card/Passport/Voter ID/Driving License).
3. Carry the Examination Admit Card/Call Letter without fail.
4. Late entry beyond 15 minutes of the start time will not be permitted.

Items to Bring:

5. Black or Blue ball-point pen (No gel pens).
6. Hall ticket, valid photo ID, and any documents instructed by the department.
7. A transparent water bottle is allowed.

8. NOT ALLOWED:

Mobile phones, smartwatches, Bluetooth devices, earphones, books, notes.

Examination Conduct:

9. Candidates must take their allotted seats as per the seating plan.
10. Question papers will be distributed 5 minutes before the start; answer writing begins only after instruction.
11. Maintain strict silence in the hall. Any communication with other candidates will be treated as misconduct.
12. Follow invigilator's instructions at all times.

Prohibited Practices:

Any of the following may lead to disqualification:

13. Cheating, copying, or attempting to obtain help.
14. Possession of banned materials or electronic gadgets.
15. Misbehavior, arguing with invigilators, or disturbing others.
16. Writing identifying marks or personal details on the answer sheet.

After the Examination:

17. Stop writing when time is called; failure to do so may lead to answer sheet cancellation.
18. Submit the answer booklet and all additional sheets to the invigilator before leaving.
19. Candidates must exit the examination hall silently and in an orderly manner.

Additional Instructions:

20. No re-examination will be held for those absent.
21. Ensure you check the website for updates.
22. In case of any discrepancy, contact the examination authority before the test date.

Online Interview:

Qualified candidates will be shortlisted for interviews. Date of Online Interview: 26th and 27th May 2026.

Documents Required During Interview:

- Pass certificate and Marksheet of Class 10 (DoB proof)
- Marksheet of Class 12 / Intermediate or equivalent
- Certificates & Marksheets of Graduation
- Certificates & Marksheets of Post-graduation
- College Leaving Certificate
- Migration Certificate
- Candidates with qualifications acquired through correspondence or distance-learning programs are eligible only if
 - a) They acquired qualifications as working professionals / while in employment,
 - b) The programs are recognized by the DEC- UGC-AICTE or MHRD,
 - c) They have passed the qualifying examination at the time of applying, with minimum requisite marks as given in eligibility criteria.

They must enclose photocopies of

- a) work experience certificate
- b) Pass certificate and marksheets of qualifying examination
- c) Proof of the program recognized by the DEC-UGC-AICTE or MHRD in letter head of the Institute/College /University, with their application.

- UGC-CSIR/DBT/BINC/ICMR-JRF and all other similar all India fellowships based on a written test for pursuing Ph.D. Admit card and Score card (if applicable)
- Caste certificate / special category certificate (if applicable) in proper format, signed by appropriate authority.
- Sponsorship letter, NOC, Experience Certificate and Facilities available to carry out the research work at their place of work (if applicable) for Sponsored / Part- Time candidates.

Note: Admission is provisional until document verification.

Exemption From the Written Test:

Candidates with valid JRF / GATE / NET etc. may be exempted from the written test but must appear for interview.
