Sec 1. Admission to M.Sc. Animation Design - An Introduction and How to Apply

The M.Sc. Animation Design Programme 2018 Information Brochure covers information related to admissions in the 2-year (4-semester) full time M.Sc. Animation Design programme offered at the Birla Institute of Technology, Jaipur Campus. The programme will commence from 2nd/ 3rD week of July 2018. On the successful completion of the 2-year (4-semester) programme, the students will be awarded the degree of M.Sc. Animation Design Programme. The institute reserves the right not to offer the programme in case the number of students found to be eligible for admission is less than a certain minimum.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Candidates must have any of the following graduate qualifications:
- B.Sc. (Animation and Multimedia) / Bachelor of Fine Art / Bachelor in Performing Arts with minimum 50% marks (45% for SC/ST)

OR

Graduate (10+2+3) in any stream from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks (45%) for SC/ST) and 1 year experience in a creative field

- 2. Candidates appearing for final examinations in 2018 can also apply and if selected can join the programme provisionally. At the time of counselling they must bring a certificate in original from the Principal of Institute stating that:
- a). By 30 June 2018, she/he will have appeared for examination in all subjects required for obtaining his/her qualifying degree.
- b). She/he has obtained requisite marks or equivalent based on latest available grades / marks. Provisionally selected candidates will be required to sign an undertaking at the time of admission on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper (as format given in Sec-11). Further, their admission will be confirmed only when they submit the mark sheet and a certificate of having passed the qualifying examination with requisite marks. They must submit proof of passing their final examinations with requisite marks by 31 October 2018. Non-fulfillment of this condition will automatically result in the cancellation of the provisional admission.
- 3. Candidates with qualifications acquired through correspondence or distance-learning programmes are eligible only if
- (a) The programmes are recognized by the tripartite panel of AICTE-UGC-DEC,
- (b) They have passed the qualifying examination at the time of applying, with minimum requisite marks, calculated as per item (1) above. They must enclose photocopy of pass certificate and mark sheets of qualifying examination with their application. (Appearing candidates in Distance Education programme are not eligible for application). Please see Selection Procedures for details. Please also see footnote below.

Notes:

- 1. Candidates with foreign diplomas should see the EDCIL website for equivalence (http://www.edcil.co.in), and if required should obtain an equivalence certificate from the evaluation division of the AIU (website http://www.aiuweb.org).
- 2. In case any Board / University awards grades instead of marks, the calculation of equivalent marks would be based on the procedure prescribed by the Board / University. In case a University does not have any scheme for converting CGPA into equivalent marks, the equivalence would be established by dividing obtained CGPA with the maximum possible GPA and multiplying the resultant with 100.
- 3. At any level of the studies [class X, class XII, graduation or post-graduation], a candidate / applicant must have passed all the required subjects at that level from the same board/ University

- To start online application, click on the link "Apply Online", create 'username' and 'password' by clicking on "New users register here" when prompted. Do not share the username and password with anyone.
- To apply for the above programme, eligible candidates must complete and submit the application form online only [link available on Institute website www.bitmesra.ac.in]. Pay application fee of Rs.2,500/- (General candidates) or Rs.1,500/- (SC/ST candidates) through State Bank Collect net banking or credit card of any nationalized bank in favour of "Birla Institute of Technology" within the given time period. [Fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances].
- Send a printout of the completed Application Form along with required enclosures (see List of Enclosures) in a A4 size envelope by Speed Post / reliable courier (means by which sender may track its movement on internet) to the office of Director, Birla Institute of Technology, Jaipur Campus, 27, Malviya Industrial Area, Jaipur-302018 (Rajasthan) positively by the due date. Write "Application for M.Sc. Animation Design Programme 2018 on top of the envelope".

Sec-3 Counselling, Aptitude Test, Interview and Selection Procedures

Based on the data provided in their forms, the list of eligible candidates will be notified on our website and updated when required. Candidates will be shortlisted for Counselling, Aptitude test and Interview on the basis of eligibility criteria mentioned in the preceding pages and our advertisement / notification(s) on our website. All notification related to admission schedules will be displayed on the Institute website and Notice Boards of BIT Jaipur Centre only.

The aptitude test and interview for M.Sc. Animation Design Programme 2018 will be held at Birla Institute of Technology, Jaipur Campus on the notified date. Students' must report at 10:00 AM on 5th July 2018 at BIT Jaipur Campus. Answer sheets will be provided to the students. Students will have to carry their own pencil / colour pencils / crayons with them. The questions will test the drawing skills, creative abilities and writing skills of the students. The interview will be held immediately after the aptitude test. The students are recommended to bring their portfolio (sketches & drawings) if they have it at the time of the interview.

Candidates have to appear for Counselling, Aptitude test and Interview at BIT Jaipur Campus.

Selection Procedure:

Provisional selections for the M.Sc. Animation Design Programme 2018 will be based on;

- a) Marks obtained in Aptitude test and personal interview, provided that the candidates fulfill the eligibility criteria mentioned in Sec -1 (Weightage of marks considered in merit list is (80%+20%) respectively)
- b) Candidates will be required to appear in person for verification of documents and interview at the time of counselling.
- c) Provisional selection list, along with procedures for admissions, will be notified the day after the Interview, on the Institute website http://www.bitmesra.ac.in and Notice Board of the Jaipur Centre. No separate intimation will be sent to candidates. Provisionally selected candidates will be required to take admission by the dates given. Seats remaining vacant will be allotted to waitlisted candidates. The list of waitlisted candidates will also be announced on the Institute website and Notice Board of the Centre only.
- d) Please note that we may put up more than one admission notification on our website, to fill up vacancies, if any. Candidates should thus check our websitehttp://www.bitmesra.ac.in regularly for any updates or matters related to the admission procedures.

The M.Sc. Animation Design Programme

The Post-Graduation programme in Animation was started in year 2009 at BIT Jaipur Campus. Earlier in this discipline, 3 years B.Sc. Degree Course in Animation & Multimedia was started in the year 2005. This Programme was started on the solid platform of the successful B.Sc. Animation & Multimedia Course where Eight batches have been graduated and most students have been placed in various prestigious companies like; Technicolor India, Color & Magic, Xentrix Studios, Prime Focus, Dataquest Entertainment Ltd, Tech 3, Zee Network, Star plus, Doordarshan, Midi Tec., Marwah Studio, Beehives, Aniguru, Maya Entertainment Ltd., 3D Solutions, Tata Elxi, Reliance Media works, Rhythm & Hues, Eden Animation Studio, Crest Animation Studios, Green Gold Entertainment, Talvania Labs, Qubit Colors, Animagic, Toonkaar Sona Entertainment, ATCS, Coffiee Bean Media, Dhruva Games, HCL, Integral Solutions and other various animation studios. Some of the Post Graduated students have started their own entrepreneurship successfully.

For these Courses in Animation & Multimedia, the institution has excellent academic and experimental infrastructure. Eminent animation professionals from industries are also regularly invited to visit the campus to interact with students and to deliver lectures and conduct workshops. The Animation Department also undertakes live projects in animation from the government and industry and the students are also involved in these projects are to get the project exposure. This field is IT enabled as well as Art based, the course structure and the labs have been planned accordingly to accommodate both the aspects. The facilities include animation labs with animation design software tools and 1:1 man-machine ratio, along with an ever-increasing list of titles in the library and spare labs for extra studies. There is a common Internet lab for the students.

The M.Sc. Animation Design Programme provide value addition to the undergraduate course in this discipline and opens up scope for specialization and further learning in this domain. After successful completion of the course the students would get the M.Sc. Animation Design Degree.

Academic System:

The Program shall adopt a Semester system comprising of two semesters (Monsoon and Spring) in an academic year. The Monsoon semester will be held during July to November while the Spring Semester will be from December to May. The M.Sc. Animation Design program will run over a span of 2 years (4 semesters) with effect from July'2018. Program will contain prescribed course structure.

Course Structure:

The present course structure is being revised as per the guidelines of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) which shall be introduced with effect from 2018-2020 MAD batch. CBCS system will enable the students to opt for elective courses from programme electives and open electives. Moreover, the students may opt for any one minor specialization from interdisciplinary areas like Animation, Visual Effects, Multimedia, and Digital Games.

The software available of Animation Courses are Autodesk Maya, Adobe Production Premium, Adobe CC, Blunder, and Monkey Jam. To enhance the communication skills of the students the institution has fully equipped Digital English Language Lab.

Student Development Activities

The academic excellence which is a unique feature of BIT, Mesra, focuses on the Case Method of teaching which the primary tool for learning at BIT. Besides, seminars, lectures, workshops, educational trips, film festivals, art exhibition and industrial visits facilitate effective learning amongst the students. The students are over enthusiastic and excited to participate in the extracurricular activities held in campus or outside the campus in other institutions. Students indulge themselves in various technical clubs based on different interests and they organize various events both technical and intellectual.

Sec-9 Discipline, Rules and Regulations

Discipline

The Institute places a very high emphasis on discipline of students both inside and outside the campus. Students must abide by the Institute rules and agree to conform to the rules and regulations enforced from time to time. They must not do anything either inside or outside the Institute that will interfere with its orderly governance, discipline and image. Students must attend lectures, tutorials and practical classes regularly. A minimum attendance of 80% in lectures, tutorials and sessionals for each subject is essential for appearing in the Semester Examinations as per norms of Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). Thus, students should attend all theory and laboratory classes from the first day of the academic year. In case of absence due to unavoidable circumstances, students are advised to take prior permission from the Dean / Head. In case of absence due to illness, students will have to produce a Medical report signed by attending Physician / Surgeon with an application from their parents or guardians. In such a case, parents/guardians should inform the authorities immediately. Students should strike a proper balance between extracurricular activities and academic requirements. A student's participation in extra-curricular activities should not be allowed to interfere in his/her academic schedule.

During teaching hours, the main lobby, the library, the corridors of the Institute and the area surrounding the Institute are to be observed as silence zones. Students must not cause any disturbance / obstacle in these zones. Students must not indulge in any kind of misconduct or indiscipline or antisocial activities within or outside the campus. Students must not form a group causing any hindrance to the academic and administrative activities of the College. Those found doing so will be punished and strict disciplinary action will be taken by the authorities. Students shall not damage the property of the Institute. Cost of such damage will be recovered from students, parents/guardians of the students.

Students must always carry their Identity Card and produce it on request. In case of loss or damage of Identity Card, the concerned authorities should be informed immediately.

Students should park their cycles in an orderly manner at the cycle stands. Students should follow the rules of the Canteen. Students are advised to read the Notice Boards regularly.

Students are strictly prohibited from possessing or consuming spirits, tobacco products and narcotic drugs either within or outside the campus, and if found violating this will be rusticated immediately, without warning.

Ragging in any form inside or outside the campus is strictly prohibited by law. Any students found ragging other students will be summarily expelled from the Institute and dealt with as per the directive of Hon. Supreme Court/Hon. High Court.

Each student must read the "UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009" on the UGC website. Each student admitted to any of the Institute's programmes must submit the two completed affidavits [one from candidate and one from parents] at the time of admission.
