GUIDELINES FOR GP BIRLA SCHOLARSHIP TO THE STUDENTS OF BIT MESRA (MAIN & OFF-CAMPUSES)

I. OBJECTIVE

For over six decades, Birla Institute of Technology (BIT) Mesra, Ranchi has been engaged in nurturing young minds to encourage them to pursue academic excellence. The "GP Birla Scholarship" scheme has been instituted to act an indigenous instrument to encourage meritorious students and at the same time support socially and economically challenged promising students.

II. CATEGORY WISE GP BIRLA SCHOLARSHIP

1. GP Birla Scholarship based on merit

The scholarship in tuition fee will be awarded to the meritorious under-graduate students admitted in 4/5 year program, based on CRL (AIR) in JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations and fulfilling the eligibility criteria as under:

- i) 15 students {(10 students and 5 girl students exclusively)} will be awarded scholarship in tuition fee as per the above table under this category. The scholarship will be determined based on the CRL (AIR) in JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations.
- ii) Scholarship based on JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations will be applicable in the 1st semester only.
- iii) Further, scholarship will be awarded to the meritorious under-graduate students of 4/5 year program, admitted through JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations from 2nd semester solely based on their academic performance (GPA in the preceding semester with no backlog).
- iv) 15 students {(10 students and 5 girl students exclusively)} who have secured > 9.00 GPA with no backlog course(s) in the preceding semester will be awarded 100% scholarship in tuition fee.
- v) The scholarship will be applicable to the students from 2nd semester based on the results (GPA) of the preceding semester. The scholarship will not be applicable to the graduating students registered in the final semester.
- vi) Under-graduate students of the above-mentioned programs irrespective of any category/caste/economic/social conditions.
- vii) Students with **no disciplinary punishment including black dot(s)** can only avail the scholarship.



2. GP Birla Scholarship based on Merit-cum Means to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS)

The scholarship will be provided to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) students based on merit-cum means. The scholarship under this category will be determined based on the academic excellence in the preceding semester as well as their parents' annual income from all sources during the year fulfilling the eligibility criteria as under:

- i) The under-graduate students of 4/5 year program, admitted through JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations belonging to EWS category.
- ii) Students who have secured ≥ 8.00 GPA with no backlog course in the preceding semester.
- iii) Parents' annual income from all sources must be ≤ 8.00 lakhs.
- iv) Students fulfilling eligibility criteria as mentioned in point no. 2 (ii & iii) belonging to EWS category will be awarded scholarship in tuition fee as under.
 - a) 25 Students securing 8.0 and above GPA in the preceding semester with ≤ 4.0 lacs parents' annual income during the year will be eligible to get 100% scholarship in tuition fee.
 - b) 25 Students securing 8.0 and above GPA in the preceding semester with 4.0 8.0 lacs parents' annual income during the year will be eligible to get 50% scholarship in tuition fee.
 - c) The Committee reserves the right to reappropriate the scholarship percentage incase the number of applicants is more than 25 in a given category.
- v) Preference will be given to students who have taken admission under EWS category with current updates on the status.
- vi) The scholarship will be applicable to the students from 2nd semester based on the results (GPA) of the preceding semester. The scholarship will not be applicable to the graduating students registered in the final semester.
- vii) Students with **no disciplinary punishment including black dot(s)** can only avail the scholarship.

3. GP Birla Scholarship to the Economically and Socially Challenged Students (ESCS)

The objective of GP Birla scholarship under this category is to promote economically and socially challenged students. Hence, the scholarship will be provided to these students based on the academic excellence in the preceding semester as well as their parents' annual income from all sources during the year fulfilling the eligibility criteria as under:

- i) The under-graduate students of 4/5 year program, admitted through JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EBC/NCL category.
- ii) Students who have secured 6.50 and above GPA with maximum 1 backlog course in the preceding semester.
- iii) Parents' annual income from all sources must be ≤ 8.00 lakhs. The income certificate of parents must be issued by a Gazetted Officer not below the rank of CO/SDO/Tehsildar.
- iv) 100 students fulfilling eligibility criteria as mentioned in point no. 3 (ii & iii) belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EBC/NCL category will be awarded 100% scholarship in tuition fee under this scheme.



- v) The scholarship will be applicable to the students from 2nd semester based on the results (GPA) of the preceding semester. The scholarship will not be applicable to the graduating students registered in the final semester.
- vi) Students with **no disciplinary punishment including black dot(s)** can only avail the scholarship.

4. GP Birla Scholarship (Prize) to the Program Topper

The prize will be given to the under-graduate students of 4/5 year program, admitted through JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations fulfilling the eligibility criteria as under:

- i) The student should be topper in his/her branch in a given semester.
- ii) Maximum 60 prizes @ Rs. 15,000/-.
- iii) Topper of any under-graduate students admitted through JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations in each semester.
- iv) Under-graduate students of the above-mentioned programs irrespective of any category/caste/economic/social conditions.
- v) The prize will be awarded to the students from 2nd semester based on the results (GPA) of the preceding semester. The prize will not be applicable to the graduating students registered in the final semester.
- vi) Students with **no disciplinary punishment including black dot(s)** can only avail the scholarship.



III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The under-graduate students of 4/5 year program, admitted through JEE (Main) or Equivalent Entrance Examinations can only avail the GP Birla Scholarship.
- 2. The scholarship will cover part or whole freeship in tuition fee only depending upon the availability of funds.
- 3. The total calculated amount of 423.56 lakhs is an indicative figure and if required, the same might be intra head reappropriation based on the application received and total budget available.
- 4. GP Birla scholarship under any category, will not be applicable to the graduating students registered in the final semester.
- 5. The scholarship is applicable to the students studying at BIT Mesra (main and its all off-campus).
- 6. Students can avail only one scholarship or BIT financial assistantship at a time. The Institute maintains the right to take disciplinary action against any students who received scholarships from other sources. In this regard, each student will need to provide an undertaking stating that they have not received any scholarship from any other sources.
- Incase more than one student has the same GPA, the Committee reserves the right to award the scholarship based on the criteria as decided by the Committee Members.
- The scholarship under any category will be awarded to the eligible students who have not been awarded any disciplinary punishment including black dot(s) during their course of study in the Institute.
- 9. The Institute reserves the right to amend/discontinue the modalities as well as the types/categories of scholarship schemes at any point of time.
- The decision of the Institute on all matters for the grant of scholarship shall be final and binding.



IV. SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. The date of applying for the GP Birla Scholarship will be notified twice in a year {Monsoon (MO) and Spring (SP) Session} by the Office of the Dean (Student Affairs).
- 2. The students' scholarships in SP will be given to them in accordance with the MO results, and vice versa.
- 3. Students eligible for scholarship under any of the categories may submit completed application along with requisite documents before the last date with copies of requisite documents as prescribed.
- 4. The applications received shall be processed as per the policy enunciated above for scholarship to be awarded by the Institute based on the recommendations of the GP Birla Scholarship Committee and final approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
- 5. The list of students selected for these scholarships will be notified by the Office of the Dean (Student Affairs).
- 6. The income certificate of parents must be issued by a Gazetted Officer not below the rank of CO/SDO/Tehsildar.
- 7. The categories, eligibility and tenure of scholarship is as follows:
