

The day was successful in its sole objective to unite like-minded sports person hailing from across the nation by giving them a platform to compete and win laurels for their skills. The various sport events hosted were as follows: –

CRICKET

The cricket tournament of VAJRA'19 commenced on the 6th of November, 2019. The matches were played at Oval ground and BIT Polytechnic ground simultaneously. The matches in the first half started at 9:30 A.M. Teams of Birla Institute of Technology, Mesra and Birla Institute of Technology, Lalpur competed against each other at Oval Ground in which BIT Mesra won by 88 runs. On the other hand, teams of BIT Sindri and CIT competed against each other at BIT Polytechnic ground in which BIT Sindri won by 29 runs. Matches of the second half started at around 1:00 P.M. at both the venues. Amity and RTCIT competed against each other in which Amity won by 82 runs. On the other hand, BIT Patna and AEC competed against each other in which BIT Patna won by 2 wickets.



Cricket tournament of day 2 held on the 7th of November, 2019 was a great success attracting a huge crowd at the Oval ground and BIT Polytechnic ground. Players of the teams were bubbling with energy which showed-up in their dedication. The matches in the first half started at 9:30 A.M. at both the grounds simultaneously. The teams of BIT Lalpur and RTCIT competed against each other at the Oval ground in which RTCIT defeated Birla Institute of

Technology, Lalpur by 4 wickets. On the other hand, RCM and BIT Sindri competed against each other in which RCM defeated BIT Sindri by 5 runs. The matches of the second half started at around 1:00 P.M at both grounds simultaneously. The teams of BIT Mesra and Amity Ranchi competed against each other in which BIT Mesra won by 53 runs. A total of 5 table tennis matches for men were played on the third day, including the semi-finals and the finals. NIT Jamshedpur won the finals against BIT Mesra.


