(b) What is special purpose housing? Discuss the need and characteristics of various special purpose housing. [3]
- Q3 (a) How will you assess quantitative and qualitative housing shortage for an urban settlement? [2]  
(b) Discuss the factors that affect housing market. [3]
- Q4 (a) Mention the institutions from where the need for long term finance for housing in the country is being met. [2]  
(b) Differentiate between housing need and housing demand. [3]
- Q5 (a) Point out and explain the various causes of growth of slums in big urban settlements. [2]  
(b) Discuss how slums are defined. Why norms for declaring a housing locality a 'slum' may differ from place to place? Why universal definition of slum has not been evolved? [3]
- Q6 (a) List different well-known approaches for slum improvement and point out the reasons for changes in approach to slum improvement. [2]  
(b) Compare the general characteristics of three types of slums, a] Squatter Settlements, b] Urban blight at City core, c] Unauthorised Settlements [urban sprawl]. [3]
