#### 94.05A. (i) Starting of the special batch of 120 students for BBA & BCA (Sp-16)

The Director, Muscat off-shore campus submitted that a batch of around 120 students passing out Foundation course in the month of December 2015, who may not wait for say, 8-9 months to take admission in regular UG programs which is expected to start during the month of August September of the year. The Director, Muscat off-shore campus has requested for approval to start one special batch of 120 students in SP-16 for BBA and BCA programs.

#### (ii) Registration of BCA (Part-time) Students

The Director, Muscat Off-shore Campus (WCAS) has submitted that BCA (Part-time) students may be allowed to get registered in both Normal track and Fast track modes to complete their course as presently, BBA (Part-time) students are availing the same options. As per Normal track the students are registered for 4 years and 6 months to complete the course while as per Fast track the students are allowed to get registered for 3 years to complete the same course.
