## <u>Plagiarism Check from the BIT Central</u> <u>Library</u>

The BIT Central Library offers a similarity detection service to research scholars and faculty members for research articles, PhD thesis, dissertations, research reports, and more. The iThenticate plagiarism detection tool by Turnitin is used for this purpose. Research scholars and faculty members can obtain the report from the library as needed.

## To obtain a plagiarism report for a thesis from the Central Library, the research scholar must follow these instructions:

- The research scholar must send their thesis to the library email address, i.e. <u>library@bitmesra.ac.in</u>, from their BIT official mail ID, CC to their research guide, along with all details such as name, roll number, branch, and mobile number.
- The file should be in PDF or Doc format.
- The scholar needs to send two files of their thesis:
  - The first file will be the full PhD thesis.
  - The second file will be the overall write-up of the scholar from abstract to conclusion and future scope (excluding preliminary pages, certificates, glossary, and list of abbreviations) for similarity detection.
- The Similarity detection will be checked on a 12-word count setting, excluding bibliography and quotes.
- After the similarity detection of the thesis, the report will be sent back to the research scholar's email ID.
- The scholar may need to produce self-publication proof if required.
- The certificate will be given by the Central Library/Associate Dean Post-Graduate Studies on the printout of the report.
