TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 1. Name and address of the firm / contractor.
- 2. P.F. Registration Number.
- 3. ESI Registration Number.
- 4. The Contract License Number from Labour Department.
- 5. The names of the workers to be employed in the work.
- It shall be deemed that the contractor has gone through the terms and conditions mentioned in the work order and all the terms and conditions mentioned therein shall be binding on the contractor.

BIT should award contract to a contractor by issuing the work order, which shall contain the following terms:-

- 1. Name of the contract.
- 2. Value of the work.
- 3. The date of commencement of the work.
- 4. Date of completion of the work.
- 5. The work shall be executed by the contractor under the supervision of the Officer-in-Charge of the work of the institution and the contractor shall be bound to follow the instructions that shall be given by the Officer-in-Charge of the work to the contractor from time.

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- 6. Payment: The contractor shall maintain statutory register which shall contain the name of the workers, the address of the workers, the date and hours duty of each workers and the wages to the workman. The register shall be kept by the contractor in the site and shall always be available for inspection by the Officer / Engineer. The register shall be counter signed by the Officer / Engineer after being satisfied of due compliance of all the statutory requirements. Payment shall be made by the institute within fifteen days after submission of the bill. Before payment is made, the contractor shall have to produce the documents to show that provident fund and other dues have been duly paid by the contractor. If it is found that the contractor has not deposited the provident fund or other dues or has not made the due payment to the workers then the said amount shall be deducted from his bill.
- 7. The contractor shall prepare the bill on the basis of the measurement of the work which shall be duly certified by the concerned officer / Engineer.
- The contractor shall use the materials which shall be duly specified / certified by the Engineer / officer.
- Any decision by the Officer / Engineer with regard to the quality of the material which shall be used or has been used by the contractor shall be final.
- If any defect is found in any work which is pointed by the Officer / Engineer shall be immediately rectified by the contractor.
- 11. If the contractor is required to undertake any extra work, he shall be bound to do so at the same rate for the contract has been awarded.
- 13. The maintenance period for the work shall be six months and if during that period any defect is found, then the same shall be rectified by the contractor with his own cost and expenses.

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- 14. The contract may be terminated on amongst the following grounds:
 - i. Failure of the contractor to complete the work within the stipulated time or within the extended time.
 - ii. Failure of the contractor to execute the job on the basis of the instruction which may be given by the Officer-in-Charge of the work.
 - iii. Failure of the contractor to use the specified materials inspite of the instructions by the Officer-in-Charge.
 - iv. Failure of the contractor to pay the minimum wages and other statutory charges to the workmen.
 - v. On the termination of the contract, the bill of the contractor shall be settled and if any dues is found to be payable after to the contractor, the same shall be paid to him within one month from the date of termination of the contract.
- 15. All matters and controversies relating to the job or contract shall be referred to the Registrar, whose decision is final.
