The Squad shall function under the overall supervision of the Anti-Ragging Committee and in accordance with the provisions of the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Anti-Ragging Squad:

- Conduct regular and surprise inspections of identified vulnerable areas on the campus, including classrooms, corridors, canteens, playgrounds, parking areas and other common gathering places within the Institute premises.
- Interact regularly with students, particularly first-year students, to identify any signs of intimidation, harassment, or ragging.
- Respond immediately to any complaint and conduct preliminary inquiries into reported incidents of ragging and submit a factual report with recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee.
- Ensure that all complaints received are treated confidentially and that the identity of complainants and witnesses is protected to the extent possible.
- Counsel students involved in minor disciplinary issues, wherever appropriate, and educate them about the legal consequences of ragging.
- Create awareness among students regarding anti-ragging laws, institutional policies, and the punishments prescribed under UGC Regulations and applicable laws.
- Assist the Institute administration in implementing all preventive measures prescribed by the UGC, AICTE, and other statutory authorities to eliminate ragging.

This Office Order shall come into effect immediately and shall remain in force until further orders.
