**ADVISORY TO THE STUDENTS**

In continuation to GO/Notice/2020-21/4509 dated 1.3.2021 regarding the return of students to the campus, the following may be noted.

1. Many Ph.D. students and final year students of UG and PG programmes are staying in the campus. However, their reporting to the campus was optional except for the Ph.D. students who are getting Institute Research Fellowship.
2. All students other than Ph.D. and final year of UG and PG programmes have been provided a window for physical reporting during 10.5.2021 to 14.5.2021 as per the above notice.
3. In the said notice, it has been mentioned that the teaching learning process including assessment and examination will continue to remain in online mode for SP 2021 and SS 2021.
4. However, if there are any pending laboratory courses of MO 2020 and SP 2021, the concerned students may report physically and conduct their laboratory experiments as per the advice of their teachers and Head of Department.
5. In the above case also, if a student opts for completing the pending laboratory courses in online mode, then the same will be facilitated by the concerned teachers and the Head of Department.
6. In last few days, the number of active cases of COVID-19 has increased in the country and in the state of Jharkhand. If this trend continues then the second peak in the number of active cases in our country would be much higher than the first peak.
7. Students other than Ph.D. and final year of UG and PG programmes are hereby advised to contact their Head of Department to find the academic requirement and the need for their physical presence to complete the pending laboratory courses. Then only they should plan their journey.
8. Their reporting to the campus will also depend upon the prevalent orders from the Government at that time. The Government of Jharkhand has issued an order on 6.4.2021, according to which the students are not supposed to report to the campus as there is a restriction on the congregation of persons both indoor and outdoor. This order from the Government of Jharkhand is valid up to 30.4.2021.
9. In view of the above points, the students other than Ph.D. and final year of UG and PG programmes are advised not to book their tickets for return to the campus. They should wait and watch the situation due to COVID-19 and regularly see the website of the Institute as well as the orders issued by both the Government of India and the Government of Jharkhand.
