- 43.37 Initial steps have been taken to set up an Extension Centre for Bio & Life Sciences at Bangalore.
- 43.38 As decided in the last meeting, 'Corpus Fund' is now credited with the overhead charges earned from sponsored projects and consultancy services after deduction of administrative expenses.
- 43.41 Construction work for expansion of the Institute Dispensary building has been completed and procurement of equipment, ambulances, etc. for enhanced medical facilities is in the process. Action has been made for modernization of Dispensary, setting up of pathology lab, training and recruitment of manpower.
- 43.42 As directed by the Govt. of Bihar, letter has been sent to Central University, Bihar, with a request to vacate the premises of BITEC Patna at the earliest. Reply to the Institute is awaited.
- 43.43 National University of Study and Research in Law has informed that presently there is no requirement of 39.0 acres of land as was earlier negotiated. Accordingly a revised MoU is being finalized for signature by both the parties.
- 43.44 Appropriate steps have been initiated for gradual withdrawal as well as for settling other issues amicably in regard to Management of ITI, Digha (Patna) and Women ITI, Digha.
- 43.48 As it is decided to adapt UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulation 2010 in the Institute, a new MoA, Rules & Regulations of the Institute are being finalized and are to be placed before the Board for approval.

44.03 ANNUAL REPORT 2010-11

The Vice Chancellor presented the Annual Report of the Academic year 2010-11. The Board noted all round performance of the Institute and appreciated the progress of the Institute to achieve its mission and vision.

44.04 ANNUAL ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT REPORT 2010-11

The Annual Accounts and the Auditor's Report for the financial year 2010-11 were perused, recorded and adopted.

44.05 BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR FY 2011-12 AND FINANCE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Budget Estimates for the Financial Year 2011-12 were considered and approved. The proposed budget estimate considered a deficit of Rs. 1636.39 lakhs comprising of Rs. 2169.47 lakhs arising out of capital deficit and Rs. 533.08 lakhs arising out of recurring surplus. It was also noted that a sum of Rs. 800.00 lakhs has been taken as estimated depreciation for the year 2011-12, leaving a gap of Rs. 836.39 lakhs as net cash deficit.

This estimated cash deficit is proposed to be met by the following methods

- (a) By curtailing expenditure to the extent possible,
- (b) By revising fee structure for the courses,
- (c) By facilitating consultancy services.

The Board noted that the XXI Convocation was held on 24th February, 2011 and Hon'ble Chancellor of the University, His Excellency, the Governor of Jharkhand, Shri M.O.H. Farook presided over the occasion. Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, former President of India delivered the Convocation Address as the Chief Guest.

The Minutes of the Forty Third meeting of the Board of Governors of the Institute was confirmed.

REPORT ON THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING :

The follow-up actions taken on the minutes of the 43rd meeting were presented before the Board as under for kind information –

- 43.05 The recommendations of the Finance Committee as approved by the Board were implemented.
- 43.05.02 Fee structure and allied charges of all the UG courses as well as PG courses were revised as approved by the Board and implemented with effect from the academic year 2011-12.
- 43.12 The organizational structure of the Institute as approved by the Board has been implemented with effect from April 01, 2011.
- 43.14 As approved by the Board for formation of Institute Management Committee(s) for Extension Centres as applicable, an Institute Management Committee has been formed for BIT Extension Centre Deoghar.
- 43.15 Administrative order has been issued for implementation on revision in age of superannuation of the different categories of employees following the UGC Regulations 2010 and action has been taken for amendment of Clause 13(2) of the Regulation of the Institute.
- 43.19 Appointment of Emeritus Professors has been introduced and the following faculty members were accordingly appointed –
 a) Dr. Ashok Misra
 b) Dr. N. C. Mahanti
- 43.20 MoU signed between the Institute and RAK Training Ship Sindbad, RAK (UAE) has been concluded.
- 43.21 Action has been taken for closure of the International Centre at Bahrain gradually so as to close its activity by February 2013.
- 43.22 As approved by the Board as well as no new students was admitted, action has been taken to close the International Centre at Mauritius by October 2012.
- 43.24 Revised format (i.e. only in English) of Degree Certificate has been introduced in the Institute from this academic year.
- 43.29 As approved by the Board, 1 GBPS internet connectivity under National Knowledge Network (NKN) programme has been extended to this Institute.
- 43.30 The Institute has entered into an agreement with M/s Birlasoft for implementation of the Peoplesoft Campus Solution, a product of M/s Oracle. The implementation process is under progress and as per the agreement the work is expected to be operational by August 2012.
- 43.34 Admission in BE programmes based on AIEEE ranking only has been introduced in the BITEC Jaipur with effect from academic year 2011-12.
- 43.35 Centre for Excellence in Climatology has been set up in the Institute.
- 43.36 The Institute is going slow for having collaboration with PSUs for setting up of new extension centres following the guidelines of UGC Regulation 2010.

The Board considered and approved the Technical Council's recommendations for the award of Ph D Degree to the scholars as well as award of Degree/ Diploma to the students found eligible as per respective Rules and Regulations of the Institute.

Resolved that these scholars / students be admitted to the Degree / Diploma in various disciplines in the ensuing convocation

OPENING / OPERATION OF BANK ACCOUNT

The Board approved opening of new accounts, closing of accounts and changes in signatories of various Bank Accounts as per details enclosed as Annexure – II.

NEW MOA & RULES FOR

(a) **“Birla Institute of Technology Society” a Society, to be governed by the Societies Registration Act, 1860.**

(b) **“Birla Institute of Technology” an Institution Deemed to be University, to be governed by the UGC Regulations, 2010.**

The Board approved the draft Memorandum of Association and Rules & Regulations of Birla Institute of Technology Society. It was noted that the said Society will be taking over the assets and liabilities of the earlier Society in the name of “Birla Institute of Technology” registered with the undivided State of Bihar under Registration Number 246 of 1986-87.

Resolved that “Birla Institute of Technology Society” be registered with the concerned Authorities in the State of Jharkhand and Dr. Ajay Chakrabarty, Vice Chancellor, and Dr. D. Sasmal, Acting Registrar of Birla Institute of Technology, be and are hereby severally authorized to take necessary steps for registration of the said Society.

Further the Board approved the proposal for formation of a sub-committee to consider the new format of UGC and to incorporate all the clauses contained in the UGC Regulations 2010 in MOA and Rules & Regulations of BIT, the Institution Deemed to be University. The same will then be put-up by the sub-committee for final approval of the Chairman. Thereafter the modified MOA and Rules & Regulations will be forwarded to UGC for approval. 44.10 MOU WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF JHARKHAND

The Board considered and approved the draft of fresh MOU for the next five years with the State Government of Jharkhand with effect from 01.04.2012 in respect of providing 50% seats for admission of students in all UG/PG programmes being offered at BIT, Mesra and the State Govt. shall provide an amount equivalent to 50% DA/ADA and additional liability due to Pay revision to the employees of the Institute, as per terms of the MOU.

44.11 SALE OF LAND IN THE PREMISES OF EXTENSION CENTRE LALPUR

The Board discussed at length on the issue of sale of land in the premises of BIT Extension Centre, Lalpur, (Plot Nos. 1433 & 1434) and agreed for sale of excess land out of 159.75 kathas of land occupied by the tenants for more than 50 years, at a price as per present valuation fixed by the Government of Jharkhand provided permission is sought from the Court or appropriate authority in this regard prior to disposal of land as per Tenancy Act of the State Government. The Board authorized the Registrar to take necessary action and signatory for signing of the Conveyance Deeds for the excess land as stated above.

44.12 SALE OF 3.63 ACRES OF LAND AT CHAKLA

The Board discussed on the issue of sale of 3.63 acres of land at Chakla acquired by the Institute in the name of Director, BIT-STEP. Mr. Surender Singh, IAS, Commissioner of South Chhotanagpur Division, advised to look into the Chhotanagpur Tenancy Act and Mutation status. The Board authorized the Vice Chancellor or its nominee to take necessary steps in the matter.

44.13 STAFF MATTERS

Matter pertaining to Extensions/Renewal of contract, Contract Appointment, Re-employments, Resignation, Superannuation and Study Leave in respect of Staff were reported to and approved by the Board as per details as under :

Noted that with due approval of the competent authority the Contract Appointment of Staff members have been extended/renewed on existing terms and Pay-scales / Consolidated Salary.

Noted that with due approval of the competent authority, a few Contract / Temporary Appointments have been made during 2010-11 in accordance with Rules & Regulations of the Institute.

Noted that with due approval of the competent authority, staff members have been re-employed during 2010-11 in accordance with Rules and Regulations of the Institute

Noted that 23 staff members have retired from the Institute service on attaining the age of superannuation in accordance with Rules and Regulations of the Institute.

Noted that 29 staff members have been granted Study Leave / Lien / Deputations / Extra Ordinary Leave during 2010-11.

44.14 RECRUITMENT OF FACULTY / STAFF

The Vice Chancellor informed the Board that Selection Committee meetings were held from June to December, 2011. The Board, on the recommendations of the appropriate Selection Committees, approved the appointments as per Annexure IX.

44.15 RECRUITMENT FROM SC & ST

The Board noted that measures are being taken for recruitment of various faculty as well as administrative positions from SC and ST category as per statutory reservation policy applicable to the Institute.

44.16 DEPUTATION TO BIT INTERNATIONAL CENTRES:

Faculty/staff members of the Institute are being deputed to serve in the International Centres of the Institute. Their salaries are being paid by the respective strategic partners for the duration of their stay. For the purpose of counting their continuous service in the Institute, it is recommended that the deputation period of such employees be treated as Extra Ordinary Leave (EOL). It was mentioned that they are not entitled for PF, gratuity and leave encashment facility during the period on EOL. The proposal was presented and approved by the Board.

44.16.1 INTERNATIONAL CENTRE : RAS AL KHAIMAH

The Board noted on winding up of Royal College of Applied Sciences & Technology and approved initiation of new entity at RAS-al-Khaimah Free Trade Zone for operation of the International Centre at Ras-al-Khaimah.

44.18 MATERNITY LEAVE

The Board approved and adopted the following resolutions in respect of amendment of existing Leave Rules of the Institute which will be effective from 23rd January 2012.

44.18.01 Resolved that a permanent (confirmed) female employee shall be eligible for 180 days Maternity Leave with full pay, to be availed twice in her entire service period. Maternity leave may also be granted in case of miscarriage including abortion, subject to condition that the total leave granted in this respect is not more than 45 days in her entire career and application for grant of such leave is supported by appropriate medical certificates.

44.18.02 Further the Maternity leave may be combined with earned leave, half-pay leave or extra ordinary leave, but any leave applied for extension of Maternity leave may be granted if the request is supported by appropriate medical certificate.

44.19 SABBATICAL LEAVE

A faculty member of the Institute will be entitled to 04 months of sabbatical Leave (or part thereof) with full pay and allowances on completion of every six years continuous service for improving his academic standard as prevalent in other reputed Institutions.

The Board approved the proposal. The amendment of leave rules as above shall be effective from 23rd January 2012.

EARNED LEAVE ENCASHMENT

An eligible employee of the Institute on completion of a minimum period of five years uninterrupted service should be entitled for encashment of accumulated earned leave. The encashment will be up to a maximum of 300 days as per UGC guidelines.
The Board approved the proposal. The amendment of leave rules as above shall be effective from 23rd January 2012.

ARREAR PAYMENT OF 5TH PAY REVISION

The Board noted the status regarding arrears payment of 5th Pay revision and agreed that the balance amount payable to the employees be paid by the Institute in installments.

ARREAR PAYMENT OF 6TH PAY REVISION

The Board noted the status regarding arrears payment of 6th Pay revision and agreed that the balance amount payable to the employees be paid by the Institute in installments.

DEAN (ADMINISTRATION & CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT)

In view of Diamond Jubilee Celebration of the Institute in 2015, the Board approved the proposal for appointment of Dean (Administration & Campus Development) in the Institute to manage construction and other campus development activities at Mesra Campus and Extension Centres.

IN-CHARGE (ADMINISTRATION AND CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT)

The Board considered and approved the proposal for appointment of In-charge / Administrative Officers (Administration and Campus Development) in view of enhanced campus activities as a result of increasing campus population.

OFFICER ON SPECIAL DUTY (OSD)

The Board considered and approved the proposal for appointment of post retired highly experienced, knowledgeable and well qualified persons from Government or other reputed Institutions like IITs on contract for a period not exceeding three years at a time as OSDs for various academic, research and administrative positions. The Board also noted that one such appointment has been made to Mr. T. R. Maiti (ex-Asst. Registrar, IITKGP).

The Board considered and approved the proposal for appointment of faculty as Deans / HODs on rotational basis as per UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulation 2010. The normal tenure of Dean/ HODs should not exceed three years. Further they may be appointed initially for two years and in exceptional case, the tenure may be extended for another year.

POSITION OF REGISTRAR/DEPUTY REGISTRAR/ASST REGISTRAR

The Vice Chancellor informed the Board that Selection Committee meeting were held in December 2011 for recruitment to the post of Registrar/Deputy Registrar/Asst Registrar.

The Board approved the following posts :

 - Dy. Registrar - 05 posts
 - Asst Registrar - 12 posts.
- (ii) For each BIT Extension Centre -

- Registrar (except for the post of Registrar). - Member Secretary

The Board approved and ratified the above.

- (iii) The Board considered and approved the proposed Administrative organization under Registrar of BIT, Mesra.

REQUIREMENT OF EIGHT COUNSELORS

Considering the rapid changes in social system in the country, the Board approved the proposal for appointment of eight professional Counselors - four for Institute Main Campus (Mesra) and two each for Patna and Deoghar

Extension Centres, in order to support the increasing students community and employees of the Institute.

44.29 QUALIFICATION FOR DIRECTORS OF EXTENSION CENTRES

The Board has approved the essential qualification, and power & functions for the post of Directors of Extension Centres as below :

Essential qualifications

- (i) A Ph.D. degree in Engineering/Technology/Science/Management. At least 12 years experience in UG and PG teaching and/or research at the University/Deemed University, National level institutions recognized by MHRD/UGC out of which at least 6 years of experience as a Professor.
- (ii) An eminent scholar with evidence of published work of high quality, contribution to educational renovation, design of new courses and curricula and experience in successfully guiding at least two Ph.D. students.
- (iii) Candidates from industry should possess a Ph.D. and other equivalent experience.

Power & Functions

The Director of Extension Centres shall be responsible for day to day activities of the centre. The Director will directly report to the Vice Chancellor for assignment and discharge of his/her duty.

44.30 QUALIFICATION FOR EQUIVALANCE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF CA

The Board discussed and approved the qualification of Chartered Accountant for equivalence. For the position of Dy. Registrar and Asst Registrar dealing with Accounts, Audit, budgeting, stores and purchase, the Members of CA of India will be treated equivalent to PG Degree with one year experience. The properly constituted selection committee may fix their basic salary at the entry level up to Rs.26000/- in PB-3 for the post of Assistant Registrar and up to Rs.38,000/- in PB-3/PB-4 for the post of Deputy Registrar respectively.

44.31 NBA ACCREDITATION

The Vice Chancellor appraised the Board about the visit of NBA Team during March 25 – 27, 2011 and Sept. 23 – 25, 2011 for accreditation of the UG and PG programmes being conducted by the Institute. The status of accreditation are as follows :

The Board noted and approved Decentralization of examination for all PG courses which have initially been initiated from SP/2012 for ME,M.Tech.,M.Pharm and MUP courses.

44.35 MoU WITH NUSRL

The Board approved the draft MOU for finalization of fresh MoU with National University of Study & Research in Law as per letter received from NUSRL.

44.36 CENTRAL UNIVERSITY BIHAR, PATNA

The Board was informed about requirement of additional space by the Institute for commencing B. Arch and PG (Engg) programmes at BIT Extension Centre, Patna. As per directive of the Bihar Government, vide letter No. V. Pra (11)/ ...05/9 – 2877 dated 30th Nov. 2011, the Central University, Bihar, has been requested to vacate the allotted premises at the earliest.

- b) An MOU has been signed between BIT Mesr and Govt. of Jharkhand.
- c) The Institute will receive Rs.12.50 crore in 3-4 phases.
- d) In the first phase, the Institute will receive Rs. 1.50 crore in 2011-12.

44.40 STATUS OF SPECIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMME (SAP)

The Board was informed about the status of special assistance received from UGC under SAP-II programme and the grants received by various Departments against the projects were noted.

44.41 STATUS OF FUND FOR IMPROVEMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMME (FIST)

The progress in respect of FIST-I and FIST-2 schemes was presented and noted by the Board.

44.42 INSTITUTE RESEARCH PROGRAMME & HIGH VALUE FELLOWSHIP

The Institute introduced the All India Admission Test for its Ph.D. program through open advertisement since Jan, 2011. The Test consists in two parts.
Part - I : Comprehensive aptitude test and common to all candidates.

Part – II : Subject specific test and from the area in which the candidate wants to pursue the Ph. D. Program.

Two such tests have been conducted in 2011 - one in Jan 2011 and the other in Aug.2011. The response to the programme was encouraging and 159 students joined the programme during the year 2011.

The Institute also offered Institute Research Fellowship of value Rs. 16000/18000. pm and High Value Fellowship ranging up to Rs. 40000.00 pm since Jan 2011 to motivate academically sound young graduates to participate in research /teaching. The Institute fellowship is awarded on an average of two students for each academic department on the basis of merit

in admission test whereas the High Value Fellowship is awarded on the recommendation of the Departmental Academic Committee together with a high-level committee constituted for this purpose to the scholar qualifying the admission test. At present, there are 59 Ph.D. scholars (BIT Mesra – 48, BIT Extension Centre Noida-2, BIT Extension Centre Jaipur-1, BIT Extension Centre Patna – 3 and BIT Extension Centre Deoghar – 5) getting Institute Research Fellowship while one scholar at BIT Mesra is getting High Value Fellowship of Rs. 30000.00 pm.

44.43 DISPLAY OF ANSWER SCRIPTS

- (a) The Board noted that the answer scripts would be shown to the existing students within 15 days of declaration of results / submission of grades. Any grade change will have to be submitted by teachers to respective Deans through HODs. Answer scripts are to be preserved only for 18 months after graduation.
- (b) For students who are no longer in the role and the students who have graduated and left, answer scripts will be preserved for not more than 36 months.

44.44 INSTITUTE ETHICS POLICY

The Board approved compilation of a comprehensive ethics policy and uploading the same in the Institute web sites as well as making available to stakeholders.

The Board noted that the Institute has been granting admission of NRI/Foreign National students on merit basis as per UGC/AICTE directives.

44.48 DISCONTINUATION OF M.E. COURSE WITH IE(I) COLLABORATION

The Board approved discontinuation of M.E. Course in collaboration with Institution of Engineers (I) till fresh UGC approval is obtained in view of UGC letter No. 6 – 3/1983 (CPP – 1) dated 30 Dec. 2011.

44.49 CAMPUS PLACEMENTS

The Board noted with satisfaction the campus placements position of the Institute.

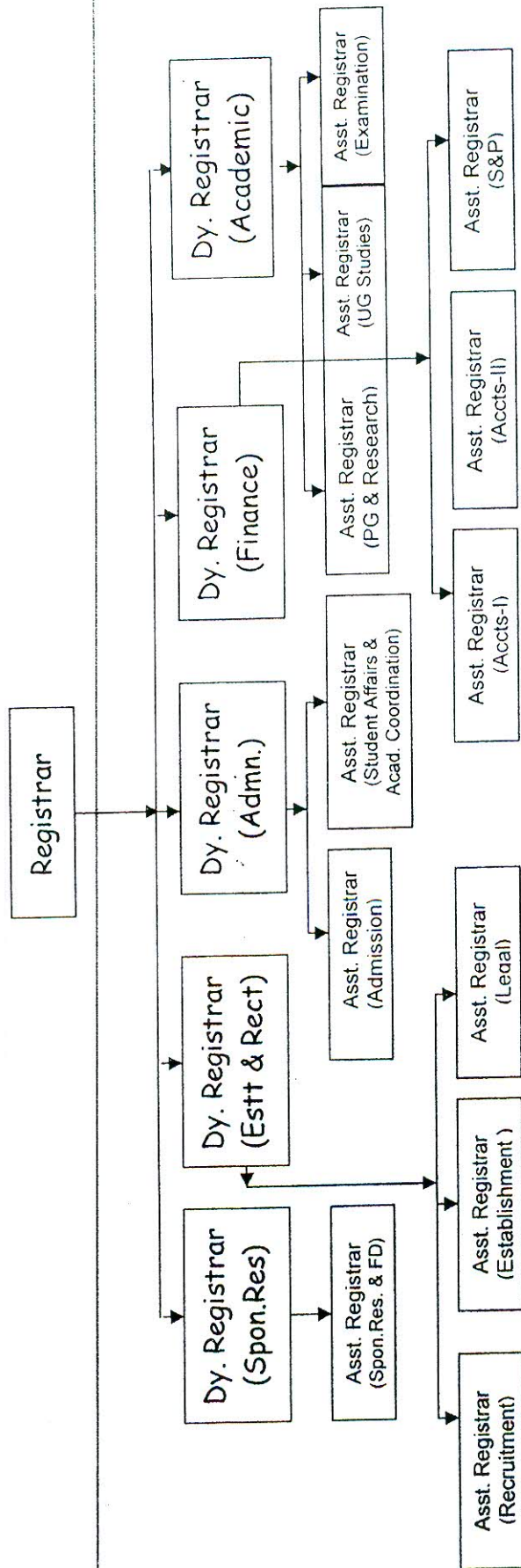
