	i) OPTION	FOR THE STUDENTS (WHO FAILED IN MOO PTEL+ COURSES AS MOOC.	



The ACAP recommended that the students who failed to score pass marks (40 for UG and 50 for PG) in their NPTEL SWAYAM courses of 12 weeks, NPTEL+ a self-paced course which is open for registration throughout the year can be an alternative to pass in the same course in that semester itself. However the selected course should be of same credit as registered earlier.

The certificate awarded mentions "Qualified" if the student scores at least 50% in all assessments. The NPTEL+ should be allowed for those who are unsuccessful in NPTEL-SWAYAM and willing to complete the course at the earliest. The maximum grade awarded in this case will be C.

The ACAP further recommended that those students who failed in SWAYAM may be allowed to register in any other course of their choice in NPTEL+ if the course in which they failed is not available under SWAYAM, as it is found that some courses in SWAYAM are not available in self-paced NPTEL+. Further, students who failed in the first attempt in SWAYAM can also register in ANY other course in SWAYAM in the next or Special Spring / Monsoon semester in case they are not inclined to take a course from NPTEL+. In all the cases same credit weightage shall be maintained.

ii) INCLUSION OF COURSE "COMMUNICATION SKILLS" FOR ALL UG PG. The ACAP recommended to include and implement the course on Communication

Skills in collaboration with Cambridge Assessment English for all Undergraduate, Postgraduate students including students of Dept. of PST except PhD.

iii) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE PG (NON-GATE/NON-GPAT) STUDENTS.

- a) Financial Assistance of 6500/- Per Month.
- b) Offering to top 20% of the Self- Financed Students securing CGPA 8 & Above.

Financial assistance of Rs.6500/- per month for a duration of 10 months (3rd & 4th semester) during the project semester of the PG program in the Institute shall be offered to the top 20% of the self-financed PG (Non-Gate/Non-GPAT) students across all the departments securing CGPA of 8 and above in one attempt.

iv) Admission to PhD Program for the PG students availing financial assistance of Rs. 6,500/- per month under sponsored category.

In order to increase the number of PhD scholars in the Institute, the ACAP recommended to facilitate the PG students (BITians) admitted in MO 2022 onwards availing financial assistance of Rs. 6,500/- per month for admission to the PhD Program under sponsored category.

ONE PAPER PUBLICATION/COMMUNICATION IN INDEXED JOURNAL OR ONE PATENT FILED BY THE PG STUDENTS.

The ACAP recommended to make a provision for atleast one paper Publication/Communication in the Indexed Journal or one Patent Filed for the submission of all PG Level Theses/Dissertation. The ACAP further recommended that the Paper Published/Communicated or the Patent Filed must be appended with the theses.



vi) MAXIMUM DURATION OF ONE AND HALF TIMES FOR PROGRAM COMPLETION, EXCLUDING TEMPORARY WITHDRAWAL AND FACILITY FOR THE STUDENTS TO COMPLETE THE BACKLOG COURSE(S).

The ACAP recommended the following modifications in Clause 12 of the Ordinance for Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate Programmes 2021-22:

- a) The students are expected to complete the programme within the specified time. The duration of the programme may be extended beyond the specified duration with the concurrence of the Head of the Department and Dean (UGS) / Dean (PGS). However, under no circumstances the total duration to complete all requirements of a programme will be more than one and half times the normal duration of the programme.
- b) The time during which temporary withdrawal was taken by the student will not be counted in calculating the maximum duration of the programme for this purpose.
- c) The ACAP also recommended that the students can take temporary withdrawals for a maximum duration of 50% of the normal duration of the program.
- d) To facilitate the failed students, the ACAP recommended that these students can register (in compliance with mandatory attendance) for make-up examinations, short semesters and additional semesters for theory courses only. Students can register for the Lab/sessional courses for short and additional semesters.

The ACAP further recommended to include the provision in the UG/PG Ordinances as per the maximum duration for the failed UG/PG students to register and appear in the additional semester, short semester and make-up examination as a maximum one and half times the normal duration of the programme, excluding permissible temporary withdrawal of maximum half time the normal duration of the programme.

vii) Proposal to amend the Ordinance for Ph.D. Programme 2021 (Clause 6.1, 6.2, 6.5, 13.2, 15(d) regarding criteria for journal publications by the Guide(s), DC Members and PhD Scholars.

To facilitate the scholars and the faculty members to substantially advance their publication records and enhance the reputation of the Institute, the committee proposed the following publication criteria for Ph.D. scholars enrolled in MO 2018 onwards.

The research scholar must have at least:

two SCI/SCIE/AHCI; or one SCI/SCIE/AHCI and two Scopus/ABDC; or three Scopus/ABDC

The list of the journals accepted for publication (to be updated every year) duly discussed in the departmental meeting needs to be forwarded by each of department through the departmental policy committee to the IQAC cell and DPGS office.



The existing eligibility criteria for the DC member and the Ph.D. guide holding a Ph.D. degree to have at least two publications in the last three years may be relaxed, if required, with suitable justification.

viii) Admissions to the full time PhD programme from MO 2023 under Institute Research Scholarship with scholarship amount of Rs. 15,000 per month.

To financially support large number of Ph. D. students, the ACAP discussed the issue in detail and recommended the proposal as under:

- a) All full-time self-financed PhD scholars admitted to the PhD Program from MO 2023 shall be named as 'Institute Research Scholars (IRS)'.
- b) The IRSs after the registration in the coursework shall be eligible to get a scholarship of Rs. 15,000/- per month for a maximum period of 4 years or till submission of PhD thesis whichever is earlier.
- c) The scholarship amount shall be enhanced to Rs. 20,000/- if the IRS publishes one journal paper indexed in SCI/SSCI/AHCI/SCIE or two journal papers indexed in Scopus/ABDC.

Enhancement of scholarship amount shall be considered from the date of acceptance of journal paper, if the IRS publishes the criteria paper (1st journal paper) under the authorship of Scholar and Guide(s) only.

The Board of Studies of the Department of Chemical Engineering in its meeting held on 03 February 2023 recommended as under:

- i) To close IMSc Food Technology Program from the Academic Year 2023-24.
- ii) To change the nomenclature of the approved program "Food Processing Technology" by the Board of Governors (BoG) in its 71st Meeting to "Food Engineering & Technology".
- iii) To start new proposed B. Tech. Program "Food Engineering & Technology" Academic Year 2023-24.

The earlier proposed nomenclature of the course "Food Processing Technology" is changed to "Food Engineering & Technology" making it more generalized. The necessary modifications in the course structure as per UG guidelines of the institute are also made accordingly.
