#### **57.05 XXVIII CONVOCATION**

XXVIII Convocation was held on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2018 in the G.P. Birla Auditorium.

The Honourable Governor of Jharkhand cum Chancellor Smt. Draupadi Murmu presided and Prof. Anurag Kumar, FIEEE, FNAE, FASc., FNA, FTWAS, Director, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and a J.C. Bose National Fellow delivered the convocation address as the Chief Guest.

Details of degrees awarded were placed for information and Board noted the same.

#### **57.06 DEGREE CEREMONY FOR OFF-CAMPUSES**

Degree ceremony for Off-Campuses and University Polytechnic were held as per the following schedule:

1. 06.04.2018 – Lalpur and Kolkata held at Lalpur with Dr. Dinesh Oraon, Speaker, Jharkhand Legislative Assembly as the Chief Guest.
2. 06.04.2018 – University Polytechnic held at Polytechnic with Shri Gauri Shankar Minz, Tribal Welfare Commissioner, Jharkhand as the Chief Guest.
3. 08.04.2018 – For Deoghar, Patna and Allahabad held at Deoghar with Professor D K Singh, In-Charge VC Koyalanchal University and Director, Birsa Institute of Technology, Sindri as the Chief Guest.
4. 13.04.2018 – For Noida and Jaipur held at Jaipur with Padma Bhushan Professor Vijay Shankar Vyas, Former Director, IIM Ahmedabad and Former Member, Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister as the Chief Guest.

#### **57.07 RELEASE OF DUES BY GOVT. OF JHARKHAND AS PER MOU**

Board noted that as per the MOU signed during May 2017 providing continuity to our earlier MOU with Government of Jharkhand, which had expired in the year 2011, an amount of Rs. 107 Crores (approx.) had become payable to us factoring it from the year 2013-14 up to the current fiscal year 2017-18. This excluded the dues for the years 2011-12 and 2012-13 yet to be provisioned by Govt. of Jharkhand (GoJ) for payment. An amount of Rs. 8 Crores was released as first Instalment initially as reported in the last meeting. Institute received an additional instalment of Rs. 18 Crores in the month of March 2018 with Rs. 26 Crores thus being the total received from GoJ during FY 2017-18.

Board noted that upon implementation of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC provisions, arrears for the period January 2016 to December 2016 were paid to all the staff.

Board noted that as stipulated by UGC Regulation 2016, revisions to our Memorandum of Association and Rules were required and are being readied for submission to UGC. Board also noted that in compliance of these regulations, our partners at Ras Al Khaima and Muscat Off shore campuses were informed about our inability to continue with the present arrangements.

#### **57.14 NATIONAL INSTITUTIONAL RANKING FRAMEWORK (NIRF) RANKING**

Board noted that among Engineering Institutions, we improved upon our NIRF ranking of 2017 by 5 places finishing 26<sup>th</sup> in 2018. The 26<sup>th</sup> rank was based on an evaluation of 1106 engineering institutions including 25 IITs, 29 NITs and 23 IIITs all of which have been notified as Institute of National Importance (INI). A comparative analysis was placed before the Board.

## **CAMPUS RECRUITMENT PROGRAMME 2018-19**

### **Interim Report till 31-01-2019**

#### **Overview**

Total number of recruiters visited BIT Mesra till 31-01-2019 is 108, which has generated 614 numbers of Full Time Employments (including all Campuses) and 190 numbers of Internship offers across different sectors of the industry. Major recruiters ranging from Investment Banks to Analytics & Consulting, Automobile to Heavy Engineering and Infrastructure, IT Product to IT Services visited the campus for placement.

24 companies have visited BIT Mesra for the first time this year and the recruiters who visited last year for the first time have continued this year and the process yielded satisfactory results. Several meritorious students have received multiple offers.

The BE students of Mesra Campus with a total batch strength of 666 and a total of 554 eligible students, received a total of 398 offers and 380 students have already been placed. Considering the percentage placement of eligible students, 88% students from BE Computer Science, 73% from BE Electronics & Communication & 94% from BE Information Technology, 56% of the BE Mechanical Engineering, 63% of BE Production Engineering and 62% of BE Electrical Engineering students got offers from different sectors. Likewise, 65%, 52%, 44% and 38% of students from Chemical, Chemical & Polymer, Civil and Bio-Engineering respectively have got placed.
