#### 57.07 RELEASE OF DUES BY GOVT. OF JHARKHAND AS PER MOU

An amount of Rs. 8 Crores was released as first Instalment initially as reported in the last meeting. Institute received an additional instalment of Rs. 18 Crores in the month of March 2018 with Rs. 26 Crores thus being the total received from GoJ during FY 2017-18.

Board noted that among Engineering Institutions, we improved upon our NIRF ranking of 2017 by 5 places finishing 26<sup>th</sup> in 2018. The 26<sup>th</sup> rank was based on an evaluation of 1106 engineering institutions including 25 IITs, 29 NITs and 23 IIITs all of which have been notified as Institute of National Importance (INI). #### Interim Report till 31-01-2019

#### Overview

Total number of recruiters visited BIT Mesra till 31-01-2019 is 108, which has generated 614 numbers of Full Time Employments (including all Campuses) and 190 numbers of Internship offers across different sectors of the industry. Major recruiters ranging from Investment Banks to Analytics & Consulting, Automobile to Heavy Engineering and Infrastructure, IT Product to IT Services visited the campus for placement.

24 companies have visited BIT Mesra for the first time this year and the recruiters who visited last year for the first time have continued this year and the process yielded satisfactory results. Several meritorious students have received multiple offers.

The BE students of Mesra Campus with a total batch strength of 666 and a total of 554 eligible students, received a total of 398 offers and 380 students have already been placed. Considering the percentage placement of eligible students, 88% students from BE Computer Science, 73% from BE Electronics & Communication & 94% from BE Information Technology, 56% of the BE Mechanical Engineering, 63% of BE Production Engineering and 62% of BE Electrical Engineering students got offers from different sectors.
